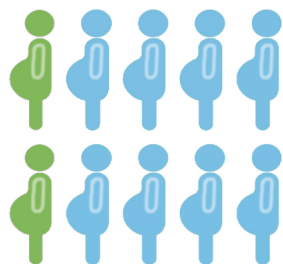
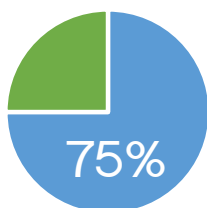


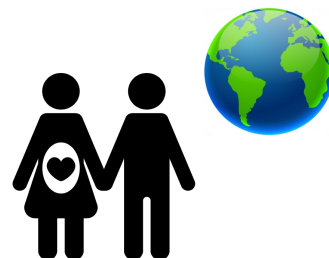
Maternal Mental Health is a priority

Over 75% of women do not get diagnosed and do not receive adequate treatment and support.
